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Minutes of the meeting of the New Holland Parish Council on **Wednesday 19th January 2022**, held at New Holland Community Centre, Barrow Road.

2201/02 **Public Participation**

Resolved: To temporarily suspend the meeting for a period of no more than 15 minutes to allow for a period of public participation. Members of the public may raise subjects, which they wish to bring to the attention of the Parish Council. Items relating to matters on the agenda will be taken first and any decisions will be made when the meeting is declared opened.

- The question of an afternoon tea for elderly people was raised. It was agreed to look at it for around Easter time and find an indoor or outdoor venue. For those who can't get out, a tea would be boxed up and delivered to them.
- Buses are speeding down the main street. Cllr Hannigan said he would contact the necessary department.
- Complaints were made about lorry drivers tipping residue such as wheat from their trailers on the by-pass and leaving rubbish. Cllr Graves will contact Bulk Services.
- Water is running from a manhole cover behind the Community Centre on to the road. Someone is looking at the problem.
- A number of comments were made about the planning application at the Magna Charta. This is on the agenda for discussion.
