Minutes of the monthly meeting of New Holland Parish Council held at 6.30pm on Wednesday 17th July, 2019 at New Holland Community Centre, Barrow Road, New Holland.

Present: Cllr Ascher, Cllr G Booker (Chair), Cllr O Booker, Cllr Graves, Cllr Rank & Cllr Woodhead.

Also present: Cllr Hannigan, 6 residents & Deb Hotson – Clerk to the Council.

Public Participation

A resident thanked Cllr G Booker for taking the photographs of Manchester Square which the Clerk passed on to NLC.

A resident raised concerns about the state of the Millennium Park hedge and the adjoining hedge.

Clerk to ask the contractor to cut the park hedge.

The Clerk has asked the adjoining hedge owner to cut his hedge back and he has stated he will after the bird season. The resident stated that when there are vehicles parked outside the property the footpath is not passable.

A resident raised an issue with regard to a building which has been erected in the adjoining properties garden. NLC Enforcement have been to visit the site but the resident was not happy with the outcome. Cllr Hannigan said he was in the process of arranging a meeting and this could be raised. This will cover all outstanding issues on Manchester Square.

Concerns were raised with regard to the parking of an HGV on the footpath along Wentworth Road – Clerk to forward to NLC.

A resident stated that the new tyres have been filled with soil at the Millennium Walk and one of the old ones will be relocated next to the bench at the bottom of Marsh Lane, all will be filled with planting. Cllr Woodhead opened the meeting.
